*Editorial*

Dear esteemed members,

Wish you all happy and prosperous 73rd Independence day!!!

Our lives today bear a resemblance to science-fiction thrillers- A Quiet Place, I am Legend and 28 Days Later with Corona virus lockdowns having us confined to our homes and hospitals. Home, for now, has become our world – the old fashioned way. As uncertainty clouds over the world in these trying times, I find myself wondering about so many “what if”s.

No physician, however conscientious or careful, can tell what day or hour he may not be the object of some undeserved attack, malicious accusation, black mail or suit for damages...

The medical fraternity has indeed been on its edge since December 20th 2018 when Consumer Protection Bill 2018 was passed by Lok Sabha. While the Consumer Protection Act has been a horror-instilling phenomenon in the litigation fearing medicos, the new amendment indeed has brought a new sense of panic with its various features. National IMA has called it a “mere gesture” and said it does not provide blanket protection to doctors until 'healthcare' is included in the exclusion list. Here are 5 major reasons why doctors are now opposing the new Consumer Protection Bill.

- 1. Lack of requirement of Expert Opinion:**
- 2. Higher Compensation Powers with Lower Fora:** The new Bill tremendously increases the amount of compensation that can be awarded by all the foras. While the District consumer redressal forum's jurisdiction has been increased from Rs 10 lakhs to Rs 1 crore, while that of the State Consumer Commission has increased from Rs 1 crore to Rs 10 crores. The National Commission will focus on cases of more than Rs 10 crores.
- 3. Non Judicial Members may comprise the Commission:**
- 4. Provision for Consumer mediation cells which will soon become a tool to harass and blackmail doctors:**

5. No penalties for frivolous and vexatious complaints from patients:

Dear doctors, henceforth we have to be more cautious in selection of patients. We have to practice defensive medicine which will be soon the future of medical services in India. Do not treat the patient unless he belongs to your speciality. Take informed handwritten consent with signs of witnesses prior to any surgical procedures. If possible keep the record of audio-visual of informed consent before performing any major intervention. Take enough time to explain everything to the satisfaction of the bystanders which will prevent future litigation from them. Never hesitate to take opinion from other specialities if required and second opinion from your own speciality in case of complicated cases. Keep a check on case paper whether each event is properly documented because in the event of legal battle of CPA, case sheet is a crucial document on which an advocate can build up the defense arguments. In case of grievous injury or death, take enough time to explain everything to the satisfaction of the bystanders. Don't give case sheet copy to the bystanders even if they request for it. Ask for postmortem if the patient dies in the hospital. If the bystanders are not willing for it, please document the same in the case sheet. Call police if you anticipate violence and record it in the case sheet. If possible take a video of the violence and write a detailed complaint against the culprits and register FIR insisting upon inclusion of the case of "Law against violence against Medical fraternity". If you happen to refer the case to higher centre, document the same in the case sheet and give a detailed reference letter and talk to the doctor to whom you are referring. If the condition is critical, arrange an ambulance at the earliest and send the staff with the patient for vital care support during transit. If necessary accompany the patient in the ambulance.

Always avoid giving any compensation or making an agreement with the relatives of dead patient under pressure as it will backfire you in future. Lastly I request all of you to enrol yourself in IMA-KPPS which will never leave you alone in the context of unpleasant situations. Be extra vigilant till we win the legal battle.

Dear friends, in this Corona Pandemic era, one has to have a lot of patience. Trust the wait. Embrace the uncertainty. Enjoy the beauty of becoming. When nothing is certain, anything is possible. Despite the concerns, the satisfying part of our professional duty is that, we are in a position to make a difference. We must embrace that. Observe the calendar of events- World Breast Feeding week, International Youth Day and Eye Donation Fortnight. May we get back the Glory of our profession that was in the past? Into such heaven of freedom may my country's men and women find space in..

President's Message

Dear esteemed members,

Covid-19 pandemic has raised numerous challenges all around the world. The health care system is at breaking point in many developed countries. Keeping opinion of doctors in view, we need to plan as quickly as possible, to identify how we can reconfigure our services. Our frontline medical staff need to be protected both mentally and physically, which can be achieved by working together as a team. Expectations of most of the administration is to provide full support, protective equipment provision, planning and logical distribution of resources in order to gear up for future uncertainty. In this regard IMA KSB appreciates the IMA Ballari for its unique model of setting up 100 bedded private hospital exclusively for Covid patients. It needs to be emulated by other branches across Karnataka to establish DGHC at District places and also bigger taluks.

The president and secretaries meet on 02/08/20 was informative and IMA KSB motivated and guided many branches in fighting against this pandemic.

Whenever the doctors ask for protection or raise their voice against the violence, their demands are hardly given attention - the fraternity is reminded of the nobleness of the medical profession and the Hippocratic Oath. The remedial altars, the courts, direct them not to protest and return to work.

The Recent spurt of attacks on Doctors and on hospitals and clinics is alarming. Violence can never be justified, least of all against someone who is ostensibly attempting to save a person's life. In the past 10 years, nineteen state governments of India have passed laws for the safeguard of physicians. Though stringent ordinance on Epidemic Disease Act is promulgated by your esteemed government, in none of above cases of violence on Doctors, it's being recorded in FIRs. The law could not be effectively implemented due to resistance from administration.

The courts should change their outlook in the wake of the new ordinance. If these very warriors are ostracised while returning from work or are thrown out of their houses, bruised by a crowd pelting stones, the courts and judges should rise to the occasion and take suo-moto action. They should deliver timely and exemplary punishments and safeguard the dignity and lives of HCWs. Healthcare professionals need a sensitive and accountable judicial system and this ordinance should be given more punch and wider applicability in the times to come.

We as doctors are fighting disease and death every day. We are subjected to a number of competing duties to patients, to protect oneself from undue risk of harm, to one's family, to colleagues whose workloads and risk of harm will increase in one's absence and to society. The satisfying part of our professional duty is that we are in a position to make a difference. We must embrace that.

The IMA has played a vital role in fighting this epidemic. IMA has been very active in the media and has ensured that the ordinary public is educated and informed of the latest developments. It has also extended an essential advisory role with the government.
