- Mother Teresa.

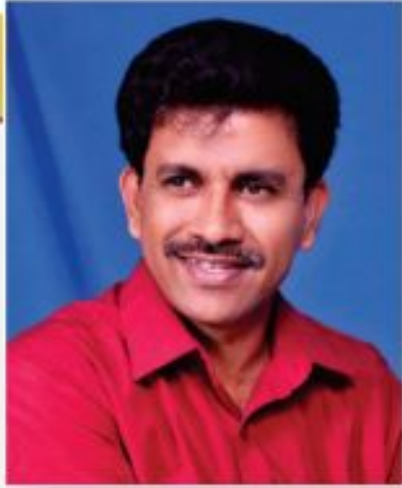

As everyone is aware about mortality among the doctors is very high, i.e. 10 times the general population because of the viral load, you should take utmost precaution and spend less time with the patients, take care of yourself and your parents and children as no one will come to our rescue.

When the government pressurised us to open the clinics and threatened to cancel the licences under the epidemiological act, why it is hesitating to cover our doctors with insurance? IMA KSB has done a lot of work in conveying the message through physical meeting, print media and electronic media but some how till now no doctors received any insurance. However IMA Social Security Scheme has come to help the bereaved families of Doctors - One of the doctor's family received 83lakhs and for that we have to salute our KSSS team and chairman Dr. Yogananda Reddy.

Our own doctor holding central health ministry spoke in Lok sabha that he is not aware of any doctors' death. It is very unfortunate to have such a health minister who is so insensitive to doctors' death. How to trust our own doctors who become politicians and then forget their own fraternity!

My sincere request to all state working committee members that we should never keep quite until we receive insurance coverage to our doctors.

Last Sunday we had a discussion in head quarters at President and secretaries meet about doctors mortality due to COVID.

Overall we have lost 450 Doctors by 02/10/2020.

Out of which more than 300 doctors were above 50 years. Single doctors clinics are more dangerous especially with small cabins and less ventilation.

Dear friends you should take care and give first priority to your health. Doctors are undergoing lot of stress because of more work, no leaves and un scientific pressures from Bureaucrats.

1. We should not keep quite by tolerating the insults.
2. Keep writing to Bureaucrats about deficiencies repeatedly.
3. The stressed doctors' have to be taken care by psychiatrists,
