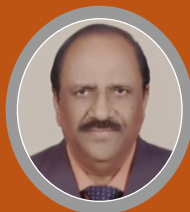

For the year 2009–10, Bidar was ranked 22nd among the cleanest cities in India, and 5th cleanest in Karnataka. National Highway 65 passes through Bidar and the whole city is integrated with 4 lane road.

Bidar is symbolically described as "City of Whispering Monuments". The mountaintop city that served as the capital of medieval Deccan, has 98 monuments of which four national monuments are protected by the Archaeological Survey of India and 14 by the State Archaeology Department, Karnataka.

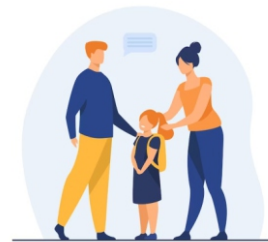

- Abstract submission starts from 1st July 2023
- Registration is compulsory for Abstract submission

- Organizing committee reserves the right to publish abstract in Souvenir
- Mode of presentation – Oral & E-poster
- The scientific committee will review the abstracts, and the acceptance and mode of presentation will be communicated.
- Best ORAL & Best E-POSTER presentation will be awarded under Faculty & Student category

### *Instructions*

#### Abstract preparation instructions

- The title should be concise and self-explanatory.
- Authors name & affiliation
- The main text should have the following headings (maximum 300 words)
- Background, Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results, Conclusion
- Keywords (3 to 5)

#### Award Guidelines

##### Theme based Full paper for Award

- Word limit, maximum 2500 (including abstract)
- File format – MS Word
- Paper should be in the following Headings.
- Title (Times New Roman, font size 14, Bold)
- Author & affiliation (Times New Roman, font size 10)
- Abstract (300 words max) in a structured format (Times New Roman, font size 12)
- Main text – Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, references (Vancouver style) (Times New Roman, font size 14, Bold)
- E-mail the full paper in MS Word format to -medicon2023@gmail.com

# Oral presentation guidelines

## Oral Presentation

- Presentation should be done (submitted) in Microsoft PowerPoint form
- Basic rules of PowerPoint presentation should be followed
- Use light clear background colour for slides
- Minimum 36 font size in headings & 24 in body
- Use clear images, figures & tables for presentation
- Limit the number of slides for presentation to 10 – 12 including title & references slide
- Title slide – Abstract ID, Title, authors (with affiliation), presenting author underlined,
- Introduction,
- Objectives,
- Materials & Methods, Results,
- Implications & conclusion,
- Reference in Vancouver style
- Each oral presentation will be for 7 minutes including discussion
- Prepare the presentation to adhere to the time allotted
- Presenter should reach the hall 20 minutes before the session

## E-poster guidelines

### E-poster

- The E-poster will be displayed on standard 42” LCD
- File format should be JPEG only
- Limit the size of the presentation should not exceed 5 MB
- Limit the presentation to 1 slide per poster only
- E-poster number, Title, authors name, presenting author underlined with affiliation – at the top of the poster
- Background, Aim & Objectives, Materials & Methods, Results & Conclusion
- Poster should be self-explanatory
- Text, tables & figures should be well organized
- Font size should be 14 or more for clear visibility.
- Use light backgrounds and dark fonts

### PLACES TO VISIT BIDAR



**Bidar Fort** is located in old city area, Bidar, Karnataka, India. The fort, the city and the district are all affixed with the name Bidar. Sultan Ahmad Shah I of the Bahmanid dynasty shifted his capital from Gulbarga to Bidar in 1427 and built his fort along with a number of Islamic monuments. There are over 30 monuments inside Bidar fort.

**Guru Nanak Jhira Sahib** is a Sikh historical shrine situated in Bidar, Karnataka. Gurdwara Nanak Jhira Sahib was built in 1948 and is dedicated to the first Sikh guru, Guru Nanak. Bidar has a very long association with Sikhism as this is the home town of Bhai Sahib Singh, one of the Panj Pyare (five beloved ones), who offered to sacrifice their heads and were later baptised as the first members of the Khalsa.

**Jharni Narasimha Temple** is the only underwater temple of Lord Narasimha in the world. Devotees have to pass through a waist deep water filled tunnel to have darshan of Lord Narasimha.

**Papnash Temple** is a Shiva Temple situated in Bidar district, Karnataka. It is believed that the idol of the temple was installed by Lord Rama on his way back to Ayodhya. The original temple was lost and a new temple was built at the ruins of the ancient temple.

**Basavakalyana** is a historical city and municipal council in the Bidar District of the Indian state of Karnataka. It was the capital of two dynasties — Kalyani Chalukya and Kalachuris of Kalyani. It is famous for the world's tallest Basavanna statue, which stands 108 feet (33 m) high. It is one of the major cities and industrial hubs of Bidar district.

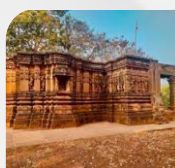

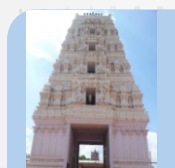
