I want to thank you all for the privilege of allowing me to represent you this past year. I had the opportunity to express your ideas and beliefs in a way that has authority, precision, and can be heard all across the country. To the best of my ability, I have sought to speak for all of us, and I hope I have accomplished that to your satisfaction.

For the past one year, along with our physical activities, we have leveraged on using the digital platform to offer a more effective impact through virtual sessions. Our team has visited 41 local branches physically and virtually, very successfully conducted one National Medicolegal conference, 4 State level conferences which included IMA AMS,IMA CGP,IMA Women's wing and IMA KSB Annual medical conference MEDICON 2020.

The agitations against violence on doctors and harassment of the professionals by the administrators have yielded us the results. We were successful in the fight to get voting rights to the non renewed IMA doctors in KMC elections.

The modifications in the KPME renewal and registration process which was much awaited was the reality this year. The need of trade license for KPME registration is removed now. Our fight against quackery resulted in government issuing orders of barring the prescription of Allopathic medicines by Ayush practitioners.

All the 4 State Working committee, 3 State Council meetings, Doctors day celebrations and 3 President and Secretaries meetings, two sports meets were held successfully in spite of the grave Covid situation. I am happy to note that almost all the IMA local branches have contributed immensely in helping the local administrators in controlling and treating covid. Many branches are the active members of the Covid task force. IMA KSB on time to time guided the Government in issuing guidelines for Covid. On many occasions IMA KSB guided its members in taking precautions in treating their patients.

We coordinated with IMA Head quarters in supplying the 3M N 95 masks at a very nominal cost to our members across Karnataka. We were in constant touch with IMA Head Quarters wherein we have attended 23 meeting with them to discuss about various issues.

All these great accomplishments can't be the work of one, it's all of us. We have so many people to thank.

Achievements


1) Land purchased

The land of 4 acres & 9 guntas was purchased and converted to Non agricultural land & got registered in the name of IMA-KSB on 8th November 2019. We are planning to build IMA Convention centre here in future.



2) The Government withdraws the order

Earlier Karnataka Government issued an order which allowed 6 months bridge course for Ayush doctors and allowed Government Ayush doctors to prescribe Allopathic medicines in emergency situations. In persuasion with the Writ Petition & series of discussions with Govt. Authorities which were attended by President IMA KSB Dr Madhusudhan Kariganur against this Govt. Order, it was withdrawn on 07-09-2020.



3) Persuaded the Government to easyfy the KPME registration process.

As a result the commissionerate of Health and Family welfare of Karnataka has issued an order 17-08-2020 stating.

- a) No requirement of trade licence.
- b) No requirement of Occupancy certificate.
- c) Auto renewal: Only pay the prescribed fee. No need of uploading the documents.
- d) Deemed application certificate.


















6) Supporting Junior Doctors Agitation on Violence at workplace

8) IMA KSB Schemes

- a) IMA Karnataka Social Security Scheme IMA KSSS: We have given Rs 82,50,000 (Eight two lakhs) to the bereaved family of Dr.Shivananda Muragode who died of Covid 19. We have taken the decision to give one and half times the death benefit contribution to the IMA KSB KSSS members and also the lockin period is removed for the Covid deaths.

 Societies Act No DRB-2/SOR/179/2019 -20 on

- c) IMA Karnataka State Health Scheme-IMA KSHS: We have reimbursed nearly Rs 35 lakhs to its 40 members recently who suffered with Covid 19




12) Doctors day Celebrations
