2. The statement of objections were filed by IMA-KSB as respondent no. 4 in the High Court of Karnataka Bengaluru through Advocates Yogesh Kumar and Associates.
3. As an action to letter received by IMA-KSB regarding NATCON-2011 account the proceedings are initiated and certified copies are sought from State Bank of India through RTI. The account in the name of NATCON-2011, signatories have been changed and new pass book and cheque book have been received by the IMA office. The letter of request to hand over the FD receipts has been written as a reminder letter to earlier signatories. The replies from Dr.G.K.Ramachandrappa on behalf of Core Committee of IMA-NATCON-2011 and Dr.Nagari Veeranna have been received, and same are submitted to IMA-KSB office.

The above writ petition were filed seeking a declaration that the Karnataka Medical Council has no power to enforce the provisions of the Karnataka Medical Registration (Amendment Act of 2003) without the Rules being framed under Section 31 or the Regulations being made under Section 32 of the Karnataka Medical Registration Act 1961. The Hon'ble High Court had granted an interim order on 29.12.2016. Subsequently draft Rules were framed.

The matters are now disposed making it clear that the registration process is once in five years meaning thereby that the next registration process will only be after five years. However, the High Court has wrongly mentioned the commencement date as 21st January 2019 since the draft Rules are yet to be published finally. We are filling review petition to rectify this mistake. However our basic contention that KMC cannot give retrospective effect is accepted. We can also urge this aspect in one more batch of writ petitions pending where interim order is granted in favor of all the members of IMA.
6. Regarding cancellation of Trade license the Nursing home committee of IMA-KSB has been attending at government level. Due to frequent changes in the ministry the result is still awaited. Legal Cell of IMA-KSB has decided to take a legal opinion about feasibility of filing writ petition in High Court of Karnataka praying for the cancellation of Trade license if the present Government do not give any hearing to our request.
7. Legal expenses are paid to Mr.Yogesh Kumar \& Associates Rs.5000/- and to Mr.Basavaraj of Daksha Legal Rs.25,000/-

There were no meetings conducted in this period. We got 2 crops of grapes during this period. We have received Rs.3,00,000/-for the 1st crop and Rs.3,69,000/-for 2nd crop of grapes.

Regarding conversion of land the procedure is complete and due for registration. We have received clearance for conversion for whole piece of land of IMA-KSB from Tahasildar of Doddaballapura and Deputy Commissioner, Bengaluru rural district.

## Report of Membership Drive Sub-Committee: Chairman: Dr.Pavan Kumar Patil:

The membership drive committee has been functioning in its fullest capacity. We have written letters to all the dean and principals of all Medical Colleges to encourage and also send us the list of their faculty who are not members. We also have approached many marketing teams of corporate hospitals and asked them to enroll their doctors to IMA KSB.

But it was only when in the last state working committee, The new membership fee was announced we circulated a message across the state about the reduced fee. Then we came to know the some facts why many in the state haven't become members they are

1. The doctor doesn't know which branch to approach
2. Many are floating/ migratory doctors in the sense Govt. doctor.
3. Many don't know the procedure to become the member.
4. Some places there are diff of opinion with the branch especially at medical college places, so they haven't approached the local branch.
5. Many doctors are attracted to become members to IMA-KSSS and also professional indemnity scheme and others but don't know how.

But now that we have informed many that if in case they r not able to approach the local branch then they can directly send the membership to IMA KSB OFFICE.

We have also been addressing, taking the opportunity at various CME and conference of different speciality to the delegates to become members to the parent organisation of medical fraternity.

As of today from 01.11 .2018 till date there have been 188 single life members and 66 couple life membership received and we expect still around 1500-2000 to be done by this year end.

I thank all the members of membership drive and also the office personal of IMA KSB BANGALORE for the constant support. I also thank the President and SEC IMA KSB and all the state working committee members for taking the new decision on membership drive.

## Report of IMA AMS, Karnataka State chapter: Chairman: Dr.Suresh T. Yavagal:

IMA-AMS Report---- Immediately after assuming the office a letter was sent to all I M A branches to start IMA-AMS Chapters if they have more than 10 members. So far no new chapters have been added.

Earlier we were ? 600 members. Today membership strength is 751. From January 2019 we have started Fellowship course in Infertility at Garbhagnana Institute of Health and Research Bengaluru. 24 Gynecologists are taking training. We have received Rs. 4,80,000/- as our share in the fees. Rs. 4,00,000/- is

Report of Subject Committee: Chairman Dr.J.Sharanappa: Subject committee does not undertake any BUSINESS, as no SUBJECT nor Any mater referred to subject committee.
Report of Sub Committee against Harassment on Doctors: Chairman: Dr.Ravi Ranganath -This committee has started to work from ground level as there is no work done on this subject previously from state IMA. Committee has forgotten that there is national to solve issue of violence on doctors. We as a committee and state IMA are completely bent upon bringing a new law or new amendment to doctor protection act of 2009 in a shorter period.

1. There are 6 police zones in Karnataka. Committee members are selected according to police zone wise area so that it's easy for a member of that zone to communicate with those local IMAs in case of violence on doctor/hospital staff
2. According to 6 police zones, 6 whatsapp group are created zone wise which will include president, secretary of those local IMAs including the zonal committee member of that zone to help them in case of violence on doctor/ hospital staff. There will be no police officer added in this whatsapp group.
3. First episode of violence when the committee chairperson Dr. Ravi Ranganatha was selected happened in Apoorva hospital, Bangalore. Post incident Dr. Meti called for get-together of all 8 IMA members of Bangalore including PHANA. Committee chairperson \& main office bearers were determined to close Bangalore for a day. But surprisingly only 30 IMA members all over Bangalore attending the meeting in spite being called for the meeting by the state President. So seeing the response from IMA members it was come to a conclusion that probably doctors are not united on this issue of violence on doctors like KPME agitation till now. So it was thought that if we call for closure it will on all likely scenario it will land in a flop show.
4. Even after Puttur communal incident of violence, a SWC meeting in Puttur itself was called so that we can come to know the ground reality of the incident. Even after requesting from the harassment committee \& IMA KSB, the hospital authorities were not even ready to file FIR on the incident.
5. As there are minimal FIRs filed by doctors in matter related to violence on doctors, it was decided to conduct a study on actually how many harassment episodes happened during last 10 years? This was planned because only few FIRs have been filed by doctors so when we meet law ministry, CM for a change in law on violence we need to document from IMA how many violence episodes have happened since doctor protection act 2009 was introduced. Only large documentation of violence to law ministry can help in bringing a new amendment to doctor protection act. Documentation can happen only through FIR \& by harassment data format filling by IMA members, \& also modern doctors who are non IMA members. Also, online signing of petition with regard to issue of violence on doctors was also initiated.
6. Both the projects were initiated in January 2019 itself. Members were also asked to fill the format \& sign the petition within 15 days. Now it's almost 6 months down the line, only $10 \%$ of IMA members have filled the format \& signed the petition
7. So somewhere down the line committee started feeling that during KPME agitation government made sure every doctors ass was made to burn. Hence doctors got united but here in case of violence on doctors it's a divided medical fraternity. Medical fraternity has not still come out of comfort zone with respect to violence on doctors issue
8. Without collection of significant harassment data \& signing of online petition, it will be a futile exercise to meet law ministry, CM to bring a change in law. Even approaching court on this issue doesn't arise till both the request from the committee i.e., significant data collection \& signing of online petition.
9. One day planned closure is planned on issue of violence on doctors from the committee in the month of July once a stable government is available
10. All IMA members will be asked to file gun licence in a month of July when stable government is available. All doctors applying for gun licence will make the government authority realise the gravity of situation \& also make patient relatives/sangha/samstha/politicians think twice before causing violence on doctors.
11. A video presentation from harassment committee has been prepared and is divided into 3 subvideos. This video presentation is done to distribute among members so that they realise the ground reality. This video was also necessary for IMA members to understand the present law, also why this situation of violence is rampantly increasing? \& also details of how IMA plans to change the present law has also been depicted.
12. Alleged medical negligence cases are on rise. This is a form of harassment which is going to increase in future. To prevent the alleged medical negligence cases on doctors, a video presentation has been made for IMA members so that they go through the video which will be helpful for doctors in understanding the present scenario on medico- legal aspects
13. It is found that 'crisis committee' has been formed in local IMAs but the members are either non active or do not participate for help whenever episodes of violence occur at local place. At many IMAs there is no existence of 'crisis committee' at all. It is recommended that 'crisis committee' be formed at all local IMAs \& only those who are passionate in serving medical fraternity to be added as member in 'crisis committee'.
14. Paying extortion is rampantly increasing in doctors' community. It is detrimental to medical profession. Only way to curb extortion is- if there is a call of harassment from a doctor to local IMA office bearers \& if they attend the call to protect the doctor/hospital; in this scenario if harassed doctor pays the extortion amount then that local IMA should not attend his/her distress/harassment calls in future. This is the only way to curb extortion. This rule should be made in all local IMAs by their president/secretary. If this is not done, extortion will become a biggest menace to medical fraternity in future.
15. As quacks are related to violence on doctors in some scenarios it is highly recommended to form anti quackery committee/cell in all local IMAs so as to curb quackery in future
16. It is highly recommended from the committee that in general defamation of medical fraternity should not be tolerated in future. Repeated defamation of medical fraternity is leading to violence on doctors. So in future IMA should file defamation case against that politician/celebrity / press who cause defamation. IMA should win such judgements. Only then defaming the medical profession will stop in future.
17. To safeguard our doctors from violence there is urgent need of developing a concept similar to 'no fly list' adopted by civil aviation ministry. We need to plan a ' no treatment list ' in local IMAs for those who have harassed doctors
18. Doctors are nowadays targeted day in and day out in one or the other ways. Days of black badge protest are gone \& so it is highly recommended that black apron protest to be done henceforth. This is the only way our problems will be highlighted during black apron protest by media/press/international news channels in a bigger way. Even public might show sympathy for doctors if we plan so.
19. As harassment data format is not being filled by IMA members because they don't want to reveal their harassment episodes to local IMAs- a google survey will be conducted through online on this aspect through google drive which will make IMA members to keep their harassment as secret at local place. The form filled by members will directly reach the committee chairman Dr. Ravi Ranganath and nobody else.
20. As many local IMA present president, secretary have not intimated the state IMA on their name, contact number \& email id, it is becoming extremely troublesome for harassment committee to contact them for different work planned by the committee. So please update yourselves in state IMA as u become president, secretary \& also when new office bearers join in. This is also request for state office bearers in this aspect.

k) "With unity and perseverance we can achieve the justice " On 27-11-2019 our IMA President has been called by the retired judge who was the legal advisor to the H\& FW department of Karnataka to submit documents and to give opinion on Ayush doctor's prescription of allopathic drugs. He coordinated with IMA KSB Anti Quackery subcommittee Chairman Dr.Mohan Appaji and as a result Government of Karnataka has issued a order of 7-09-2020 which clearly says that the Ayush people can't prescribe Allopathic medicines, not even in emergency situation and not even by Government Ayush doctors.This achievement is possible because of the guidance by many of our senior IMA leaders.
I) Dr.Madhusudhana Kariganuru attended the VC with the Honorable Health Minister of Karnataka Sri.Sreeramulu on 13-05-2020 at 3 PM to discuss about the normal functioning about the Private medical establishments. We have brought to his notice that the IMA through 176 branches are committed to the society and many of our members across Karnataka have opened their hospitals and giving their services to the non covid patients. When we brought to his and Health Secretary's notice about the quarantining of the First Neuro Hospital of Mangalore for the last 21 days and not following the recent guidelines of reusing of the medical establishment, within 24 hours after disinfection.

It was swiftly attended and the next day the hospital was freed from quarantine.

I also stressed on the menace of quacks in non reporting of the ILI and SARI cases which he replied to take appropriate action.
