Woman With Wings

Dr. NIRMALA KESAREE

She rushed like a storm inside ward number 58 (emergency ward) of Chigateri General Hospital, Davanagere and stood still by the bedside. The baby which had howled for hours together had given up to go soundless forever and laid still on the bed with the scalp vein literally in the vein of its shaven scalp by her, which was the art practiced only by her. With eyes filled, she bowed her head down, touched the tiny little foot of the baby and said...I'm sorry, I couldn't save you. She was Dr.Nirmala Kesaree, the Doyen of Paediatrics.

Let me confess before I go further on..that, this space is too short for me to write about the lady legend's accomplishments and tour de force. But, I'm sure; my readers will appreciate my efforts in making her story a memorable one.

Dr.Nirmala Kesaree was born on 14th September 1930 in the remote village of Somanahalli in the Haveri District. Her father, Mahadeva Kesaree was a lawyer and a freedom fighter. Her mother Parvathi Devi was the daughter of Mysore Basvaiah , who served in the kingdom of Sri.Krishnaraja Vodeyar in bringing up the poor. It was natural for the children in the family to have inherited the intelligent, fighter and sincere genes. Her Elder sister Malathi kesaree was the first lady engineer of Karnataka then. Her second sister Leela Keasaree served as registrar of Dharwad University for 22 years. Yet another sister Shobha Kesaree was intelligent at par. Nirmala was extremely sensitive child and took a wow to serve sick children after seeing two of her brothers, Suresh and Prakash kesaree dying at the ages of 7 and 8 due to lack of medical help. Though the family was considered elite in the society, they did not have surplus money to look after her higher education. But, she was too good to fail and took up the scholarship from Mumbai University by scoring highest in biology. She thus entered the reputed Grants Medical College, Mumbai to do her MBBS. She was an epitome of endurance and earned money by teaching hindi to foreigners, selling her own handmade knitwear and even as an announcer in Akaashavani Mumbai during her student days. She came out as a doctor in 1955, and worked in USA for 5 years and then in U.K for 6 years. For the love her hometown, she came back in 1967 and joined as a lecturer in pediatrics at J.J.M.College, Davangere. It is in this place, she built a queendom of pediatrics. She served the college as the most qualified Pediatrician of the country for 50 years.

She was a Social pediatrician...

In a country with vast interference of ignorance, she felt that parent groups should grow to bring a change in the health of our newborns. She had an inclusive practice, where she involved grand parents, parents, nurses, social workers in her clinics. Her campus thus had a kitchen, kitchen garden and even a kindergarten! She believed that "Nutrition is the Solution" to shun sickness in children. It was this passion, which made her start Nutrition Rehabilitation Centre and the Davanagere Mix, using indigenous Ragi, Groundnuts, roasted Bengal gram and Jaggary. She was successful in making this more famous than the Davanagere Benne Dose for children!

She is an Inventor...

She invented Nirmala Kesaree Syringe for retracted nipple, just by cutting the regular 20ml syringe and reversing the plunger. The application of common salt to heal umbilical granuloma was another in her inventory. The drop and drip method for breast refusal invented by her was a boon to the newborns. She was the first to start immunization services in the community in 1970. She organized mass immunization camps in 225 villages of Davanagere and Harihara taluks. She involved students, interns, nurses, faculty and volunteers from community for this massive work and carried it out successfully for 10years until the Government of India took up the Universal Immunisation Programme in 1986. She got the WHO recognized National Diarrhoea Training and Treatment centre to JJM Medical college. She implemented RCH Programme in 5 urban slums in Davanagere covering 25,000 populations. She implemented PPTCT Prevention of Parent to Child Transmission project by getting grants from Elizabeth Glaser Paediatric AIDS Foundation U.S.A.

She has been an inspiration to all those who inspire us. In the year 1994, she took up the challenge of developing the Bapuji Child Health Institute and Research Centre, which is a state of the art 200 bedded centre of excellence catering to more than one lakh children with 120 skilled members serving the sick babies and neonates for their needs under one roof. She scripted her aspirations on the emblem of this institution as "Your smile is our fortune". She was successful in harvesting hopes to the parents of the sick children here working as the Director for 22 years.

She is a Visionary...

She knew the importance of support systems, nurses and the paramedical staff in paediarics and ran training programs for neonatal nursing, infant feeding, and lactation management counseling for more than two decades.

For a game changer like her, publications and awards were routine. She was conferred with the prestigious Karnataka Rajyotsava Award in 2005.

She had gathered many feathers on her way and was never tired of studying. Her long list of degrees include; M.R.C.P(Lond.)1966, M.R.C.P.(Edin.)1965, M.R.C.P.(Canada)1965, D.C.H.(Lond.)1964, Diploma in Neutrition, NIN, Hyderabad1970, F.R.C.P(Canada) 1975, FIAP 1985, FRCP(London) 1990, FRCP(EDIN) 1990. She wrote exams at the age of 55 years to get her new degrees.

Having been over used, her brain went on strike with her and refused to remember anymore. She acquired Alzheimer's disease which she dreaded and suffered it for four years and was looked after by her own students. She laid like a small child without even recognizing her favorite students on the beds of Bapuji Hospital. She gave eternal love to all her students. For those who were inquisitive to know why she remained a spinster, she would say she did not wish to be selfish to share her love from her patients to her own children! She was like a river, kept flowing with the tide, never keeping anything for self. She donated all her earnings and property to public trusts for the welfare of Women and Children. She flew her feathers off on 5th February 2016 at the age of 86 leaving behind a legacy of dedication, selflessness, sincerity and encouragement to all those who loved her for the AMMA KESAREE she was!

She is my proud WOMAN WITH WINGS for the month.




