

The day of medical importance

World Leprosy Day - Sunday 30 January 2022

World Leprosy Day is a celebration of the leprosy community. It is celebrated on 30 January 2022. World Leprosy Day was established in 1954 by French journalist and activist, Raoul Follereau. Follereau created World Leprosy Day with two goals: to advocate for the equal treatment of persons affected by leprosy and to reeducate the public about leprosy by correcting historical misconceptions surrounding the disease.

The theme of World Leprosy Day 2022 is **“United for Dignity.”**

This day is an opportunity to celebrate people who have experienced leprosy, raise awareness of the disease and call for an end to leprosy – related stigma and discrimination. The unity for dignity campaign calls for the unity in honouring the dignity of people who have experienced leprosy.

In India, World Leprosy Day is celebrated on 30 January, the anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi's death, as Gandhiji was deeply committed to the cause of leprosy. To commemorate the anti-leprosy day, Sparsh Leprosy Awareness Campaigns (SLAC) are being organized since 2017 in order to reduce stigma and

discrimination against persons suffering from leprosy. During SLACs, nationwide Gram Sabhas in villages across the country are organised in cooperation and coordination with allied sectors of health department. Appropriate messages from District Magistrates and appeals from Gram Sabha Pramukhs to reduce discrimination against persons affected with leprosy are read out, pledge is taken by all Gram Sabha members to reduce the burden of disease in the community and felicitation of persons affected with leprosy is done. The focus of SLACs this year was to make the community aware about the importance of early detection of leprosy followed by complete treatment in order to prevent physical disabilities.

It's important to mention that leprosy has a long incubation period and therefore, leprosy eradication becomes a long-drawn process.

Ultimately, it is the early case detection followed by complete treatment that will lead the country towards leprosy free status. Efforts from the government, doctors and the society to be made to make India a leprosy free country.

IMA Karnataka State bagged many of the awards in the conference including Prestigious AKN Sinha IMA AMS award to Dr Shivakumar F. Kumbar And IMA Dr A.P Shukla Memorial distinguished award to Dr G.N. Prabhakara who will take over as chairman IMA AMS of HQ for the year 2021-22. Another notable event in last one month was IMA AMS NATCON at Thirupathi where our stalwarts stole the show by bagging 1) Best State chapter conducting courses 2) Membership drive award 3) National Chairmans appreciation award to Dr S.F Kumbar.

Our tour programme to North Canara district branches on 11-12-2021 starting from IMA branches of Bhatkal, Honnavara, Kumta, Ankola, Yallapura, Mundagod and Sirsi was a great success. The defunct branch Mundgod increased their membership by 11 new life
