Following are the important health days for the month of December

1) National Pollution Prevention Day:-

It is observed annually on December 2 in memory of the people who lost their lives in the 1984 Bhopal Gas Tragedy. Bhopal gas tragedy is said to be one of the world's worst industrial disasters to date. The aftereffects of the tragedy were also very severe as increased cases of cancer and birth defects were reported. It is not only observed in honour of people who lost their lives in the deadly tragedy but also to spread awareness on managing and controlling industrial disasters, preventing the pollution produced by industrial processes or human negligence. It also aims to spread awareness about the prevention of pollution of natural resources like air, soil, and water.

According to the National Health Portal of India, Fossil fuel combustion (for power, transportation and industry) is also a major contributor to air pollution, which causes 7 million premature deaths worldwide every year. Over 90% of the urban population of the world breathes air that exceeds WHO's guideline levels for outdoor air pollution.

The theme for the year 2021 is to raise awareness about pollution and encourage the governments to adapt policies to mitigate the impact of pollution.

We as doctors along with spreading the awareness about air pollution, air borne diseases and water borne diseases, can contribute to pollution prevention by appropriately disposing the medical waste. We can carry out activities like planting saplings, throwing seed balls which will help in reforestation and work towards achieving Swatch Bharat

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

My dear Respected Members

Annual conference of IMA Karnataka State Branch is a great success in spite of uncertainties of Covid 19 pandemic. All the credit should go to IMA Siruguppa Branch, as well as our Past Presidents of IMA-KSB Dr.Y.C.Yogananda Reddy and Dr.Madhusudhan Kariganur. Generosity of officials of Jindal Vijayanagara Steel works is immemorable. It is our bounden duty to associate with such giant organisation by having periodical medical camps in their campus in the area of their need in reciprocation to their kind gesture.

CWC meeting held at Guwahati, Assam was fruitful. Many burning issues of the professional and association were discussed in length and few amendments to bye-law of IMA HQ were carried out for smooth functioning of IMA. My proposal of IMA Medical College by 2028 while celebrating IMA centenary year was welcomed by all. Our sightseeing tour of the states of Assam and Meghalaya has given us first-hand knowledge of health care system and social well being in those states. In contrast to our belief, people are friendly and joyful. There was no evidence of violence, instead people are in harmonious life.

We had successful first State working committee and President & secretaries meet of local IMA Branches on 14.11.2021 with fruitful discussions. I thank all SWC members for the inputs regarding activities of

IMA-KSB in the year 2021-22. As a major decision we have decided to have District Councils under the Chairmanship of District coordinators for all activities of IMA-KSB. All the possible and feasible committees existing at State Level will also function at District Level. This will add fourth tier to the IMA administration, i.e. IMA HQ, State Branch, District and Local Branch to speed up the activities.

All district coordinators are nominated from SWC. It is resolved that District coordinators of those districts lacking membership in SWC will be special invitees to SWC Meetings. I thank SWC members for this kind gesture. This will enable district coordinators to participate in SWC meetings and carryout the activities in their district as proposed in SWC. Already many district and divisional coordinators have started functioning under supervision of Vice-Presidents of their area. I thank them immensely and request them to take IMA-KSB activities to greater heights.

We are giving more priority to membership drive, that is, IMA Life Membership, IMA KSSS, IMA KPPS and IMA KSHS. We are striving hard to activate defunct branches at the earliest. I have visited IMA Branches like IMA Bangalore on 7.11.2021 IMA Sullia on 19.11.2021, IMA Karkala on 21.11.2021, IMA Puttur on 22.11.2021, IMA Mangalore on 26.11.2021 and IMA Whitefield on 27.11.2021. IMA Bangalore has already Women Doctors Wing (WDW). We have inaugurated IMA, WDW in all these above five

Branches, thanks to dynamic leadership of WDW chairperson Dr Geetha Doppa. We are planning to start such WDW in all branches of IMA-KSB, wherever possible and feasible. The WDW activities will be complimentary to the activities of parent IMA local branch.

We have already visited District Council Meetings of Dakshina Kannada, Bangalore Urban and Bangalore Rural. On 02.12.2021 we will have Gadag District Council Meet. On 03.12.2021 we will have Hubli Dharwad District Council Meet followed by Belgaum District Council Meet on 04.12.2021 and Bagalkot District Meet on 05.12.2021. 11th and 12th December, we have planned North Canara District tour to all IMA local branches in that district which will culminate with Uttar Kannada District Council meet on 12.12.2021 at IMA Karwar Branch. We have decided to visit defunct branches like Naval Gund, Naragund in Gadag District, Ghataprabha and Yamakanamaradi in Belagavi District. Yallapur and Mundagod in Uttar Kannada districts, to activate them and listen to their issues.

The various committees are announced in this issue of IMA Focus and I am sure we will make good beginning for the activities of IMA KSB in the year 2021-22.

On first Tuesday of every month we will have President and Secretaries meet of local IMA branches in zoom platform at 8.00 PM, on second Tuesday of every month we will dedicate for committee meetings at 8.00 PM on Zoom platform. 3rd Tuesday will be for WDW meeting and 4th Tuesday will be for Hospital Committee meetings at 8.00 PM.

I request all concerned to dedicate their time and services for IMA-KSB. I have addressed National level TV (MIRROR NOW) on 30.11.2021 at 3.00 PM in live discussion in support of issues of Resident Doctors. Resident Doctors are backbone of our Healthcare System. They are the one in close contact with the

patients. In covid 19 pandemic their sacrifice is unimaginable and priceless. It is because of their sacrifice that India sailed smoothly in Covid19 pandemic till now. Now their Agitation is [1] Pending compensation for covid 19 Duty, [2] Pending stipend, [3] Fees hike for Medical PG Courses, [4] Indefinite Postponement and uncertainty of NEET PG Counselling. In first 3 issues State Government is responsible to take steps to solve the issues where as 4th issue Central Government, NMC and even Hon'ble Supreme Court is responsible. Hon'ble Supreme Court has held sitting even at midnight to hear urgent issues. This being a National issue on priority should be addressed as early as possible. Resident doctors are awaiting PG Counselling. If counselling was held by now all of their services could have been utilised for the health care that too when we are anticipating Covid 19 3rd wave. State Government has rightly announced compensation of Rs,10,000/- Per Month for the services of Resident Doctors for Covid 19 care. However, Government has not fulfilled the promise for the reason best known to them. Only when Residents are comfortable physically, mentally and financially, they can offer better services. Hence, at the interest of society and nation at large Government should make payment in time on priority basis. IMA-KSB requests the Government, for free or subsidised Medical Education. Only then society can have medical services at reasonable cost. We have also written to State Government, Prime Minister and NMC to resolve issue of NEET counselling. The burning issues of KPME, fire NOC, will be discussed with all concerned and will be brought to the notice State Working Committee and proceed further. I attended Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences Syndicate Meeting, on 25.11.2021 and discussed the issue of postponement of MBBS exams. We can have many programmes jointly with RGUHS in coming years for the benefit of both. I once again request you all to gear up and take IMA-KSB activities to greater heights.
