Following is the important day in Medicine.

1) World heart day, 29th September:

World Heart Day is observed and celebrated annually on September 29, with the aim of increasing awareness of cardiovascular diseases and how to control them to negate their global impact.

On average, more than 17 million people die from heart-related illnesses every year. This is a more than that of people who die from HIV, malaria, and cancer.

The annual deaths of CVD in India is projected to rise from 2.26 million (1990) to 4.77 million coronary heart disease prevalence rates in India have been estimated over the past several decades and have ranged from 1.6% to 7.4% in rural population and from 1% to 13.2% in urban population.

“USE HEART FOR EVERY HEART” is the theme for this year.

World Heart Day is an opportunity for everyone to stop and consider how best to use

heart for humanity, for nature and for you. Beating cardiovascular disease (CVD) is something that matters to every beating heart.

****Use Heart**** means to think differently. To make the right decisions. To act with courage. To help others. To engage with this important cause. The heart is the only organ you can hear and feel. It is the first and last sign of life. It is one of the few things with the potential to unite all of us as people

Psychological stress can double the risk of having a heart attack. Exercise, meditation, and getting enough quality sleep help to lower stress levels. By resisting the harmful coping mechanisms and bad habits induced by stress, we can maximise our individual heart health.

Air pollution is responsible for 25% of all CVD deaths, taking the lives of 7 million people every year. Whether they are more immediate actions like walking or cycling instead of travelling by car, or longer-term efforts such as supporting clean air legislation, each of us can contribute to a healthier planet in our own way.

Over 75% of CVD deaths occur in low-to middle-income countries..

The first hour after the onset of a heart attack is

called the golden hour. Appropriate action within the first 60 minutes of a heart attack can reverse its effects.

The Golden Hour is a window of opportunity that impacts a patient's survival and quality of life following a heart attack. It is a critical time. This is because the heart muscle starts to die within 80-90 minutes after it stops getting blood, and within six hours, almost all the affected parts of the heart could be irreversibly damaged. So, the faster normal blood flow is re-established, the lesser would be the damage to the heart.

So getting the treatment in this period is very crucial but access to the medical facility can be an issue anywhere.

As doctors all of us must be aware of the initial steps to be followed till the patient get the required treatment.

So eat well, exercise well and be calm and stress free for the beautiful heart to keep beating.

I have had the privilege & satisfaction of rendering my services as State Woman Vice President for the year 2021 2022.

I am happy that I have worked to the best of my ability for into IMA Membership enrolment & 3 schemes, particularly KPPS has been very encouraging.

Branch visit along with State president Dr Suresh Katil Kudva & our PRO, Dr G.K.Bhat has been very fruitful. We spoke about benefits of all 3 IMA schemes like KPPS, KSSS, KSHS. Office bearers & members were more receptive and interactive regarding various issues like KPME registration, handling violence against Doctors. They were happy to get updated about activities both at State level & Head Quarters level. WDW (Women Doctors Wing)

Sub Committees were inaugurated during Branch visits & Women Doctors have been proactive & voluntarily sending monthly report to Head Quarters through State Chairperson & Secretary. With joint efforts, we had 4th Annual WDW at Hubli & also actively participated in South Zone WDW held at Cochin on 16th & 17th July 2022, thus showcasing potentials of Women Doctors.

HPV Genome Pap testing for early detection and treatment of cancer cervix is being taken forward very well after we inaugurated the same on International Women's Day on 8th March 2022 at Trust well Hospital. Happy to get HPV Genome testing available to all not only at a subsidised price but also popularised the need for it amongst all women to prevent/detect cancer cervix at the early stage. 378 Asha workers got the smear done free of cost at Dasappa Maternity Hospital, thanks to Karkinos Lab. HPV testing at subsidised cost is being done in September month on the occasion of Teachers day. Also organising Colposcopists & Colposcopy (if HPV Genome testing is positive) is under discussion. However, webinar series on

Cancer Cervix continues to update us with Scientific acumen. Blood donation camp held on 1st July pan India has gained momentum. Also, CMEs on Organ Donation has motivated us to do more. I have been giving Health talks at Abalashram, Hostels, Health Camps in Schools & BBMP wards.

In spite of all these activities/ efforts, we still have room for improvement w.r.t fight against Mixopathy, amendments in NMC (National Medical Commission) draft, few of which have been very detrimental to our Allopathic Medical Education.

Activating Defunct branches and creating New branches are in the pipeline. Also, Speciality Organisations are coming forward to provide immense support & coordination to strengthen IMA integrity thus helping in our fight against Mixopathy (with due respect to other practice of Medicine), violence against Doctors, introduction of IMS, smooth KPME registration, to name a few.
