Also, the makers of Sahitya Vidyaloka of Jainakashi Moodbidri, who allowed us to hold this conference, Dr. To Mohan Alva and all his staff, to all the members of the Indian Medical Association Karkala Branch who hosted this conference, Medicon Organizing Secretaries and Dr. Y. Sudarshan Rao, my salutations to all the former presidents of the Indian Medical Association State Branch, to all the medical friends who responded positively to our call, to the family members, to the public, to all the friends of the press and visual media.

Moodbidire is known as "Jainakashi" which is named as Moodbidire because it is a bamboo growing town in the eastern direction. Totally 18 temples, 18 Jain basadis and 18 lakes are very special in Moodbidire. Moodbidire, which has been making strides in the field of education in recent years, has a rich history. Mahakavi Ratnakara Varni Mudubidire wrote one of the famous poems of Nadugannad, Bharatesha Vaibhava. Proud to hold the state presidency in this medical conference being held at such a historic place.

First of all I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all the members of the association who have elected me to this post. In the direction of keeping this Indian Medical Association built by seniors forever in the minds of the people, I am putting before you several innovative projects and seeking your cooperation for their success.

- The Karnataka branch of the Indian Medical Association welcomes the government's positive plans to address the shortage of doctors in rural medical services without harming the modern medical system. In this regard, our association has already started "I.M.A. Nade Halliya Kade" project and it will be promoted.
- 2. In our rural country, the services of family doctors are essential. Medical services are out of reach of the common man due to the current culture of specialists and corporate culture. Perfect medical education is essential if we are to be successful in improving patient-physician relationships. The time has come to re-mainstream family medicine, which sees the

patient closely and holistically. In this regard, pressure should be put on the government to create new master's degrees in family medicine. Our doctors are happy to work in the village environment if the government provides a favorable environment. The attention of the concerned will be drawn by organizing a conference on this at the state level.

- 3. We recommend appropriate changes in the rules and regulations of the National Medical Commission Bill and not compromising on its autonomy. Sections 32, 50 and 51 should be removed which are harmful to the modern medical field and allow half-baked doctors to play with people's lives. Apart from this, any kind of fake medical degree creation will be resisted by us.
- Menace of fake doctors According to an official study, there are one million unregistered unqualified doctors in our country who are playing with the lives of patients. It is far from the truth that there is a shortage of doctors in our country, doctors are reluctant to serve rural areas and the available private doctors are expensive. The irony is that there are several laws to rein in the graduated doctors but there is no law for these bogus doctors who do not have any qualified degree, if exists it is not effective. It is our responsibility to eliminate the fake doctors who are plagued across the state of Karnataka. The government should not show leniency to bogus doctors who only capitalize on the helplessness of patients. My concern is that the honorable ministers should take action to bring a law to prevent the menace of fake doctors. I will try to fight this legally through the Anti-Quackery Sub-Committee of our state branch.
- 5. Increasing violence and assaults on doctors and medical staff These types of incidents reduce the mental strength of doctors and lead doctors to resort to the negative practice of postponing cases even if they are feasible and leave patients struggling. This is the condition of those who are fighting day and night for the health care of the people. A law should be implemented to quickly arrest and punish those who attack like this. There should be a change in the existing law so that the guilty cannot get bail. Likewise, the Doctor's Protection Act should be implemented. We will try to study this through the sub-committee of our state branch and submit a report to the government.
- 6. Difficulties in implementing the KPME. It is difficult to get NOC from the fire department by the already existing to small and medium-sized hospitals in taluks and cities that are providing excellent medical services at low rates. In this regard, we are putting

- pressure on the government to implement the Fire Safety Act in our Karnataka simplified for hospitals, thereby reducing the cost on the patients.
- Indian Medical Association wants to participate in all national and state level health programmes. Our association should be enabled to participate in shaping all government work activities. I hereby request the government to facilitate us in fulfilling our social responsibility.
- 8. "Stop female foeticide, save and nurture girl child" program is a meaningful program of Indian Medical Association. In this regard, we will join hands with all government and non-government organizations. In this context, governments need to change the trend of flogging only doctors and develop programs to educate the masses.
- I request all office bearers to carry out continuous medical education campaign in their respective branches.
- 10. A lot of programs have been put in place for the career development of all the members of the Indian Medical Association. In this regard we are hoping to build a hall with all facilities for medical programs at our Sangh location in Doddaballapur.
- 11. KPPS, KSSSS and KSHS are the best schemes for the welfare of us and our members' families., I hope to upgrade the projects and increase the number of its members.
- 12. I.M.A. President's speech. On 23rd of every month at 9 pm, a dialogue program will be organized through internet platform for all the members of Karnataka. All the branches are requested to actively participate in this.
- 13. A workshop will be conducted physically in each district center on Sunday with the heads of various departments. I am asking the officials of the branches coming in that district to participate.
- 14. 20 different sub-committees have been formed under the state branch through which all the development works are planned to be carried out effectively.
- 15. Activation of women doctor branches in all local branches.
- 16. The Kannada Vaidya Barahagarara Samithi is doing very well. I will improve it further and make sincere efforts towards the best.
- 17. From the point of view of environmental protection, paperless transactions may become inevitable in the near future. Because of this, small and medium-sized

hospitals have to rely on expensive software available in the market to store medical records. Their purchase and maintenance costs are also expensive. Simplifying this and having a very low rate IMA. We have developed hospital software. All members are requested to avail it. It will be released at the next executive meeting.

- 18. Junior Doctors and Medical Students Associations like IMA MSN and IMA JDN are the future of IMA and they will be strengthened.
- 19. To increase the number of members of Indian Medical Association for successful execution of all projects.

All members feel free to share their grievances with Karnataka branch.

All those who take care of the health of the society, I request you always pay attention to your own health.

I assure that all the functioning of Indian Medical Association will be transparent.

My heartfelt thanks to all my doctor friends from Rona Branch of Indian Medical Association and Gadag Branch who have supported me till now.

HIGHLIGHTS OF IMA KPPS

(IMA Karnataka State's Professional Protection Scheme)
By Dr K G Shankarnarayana (with inputs from Dr Madhusudana Kariganoor)

I am sure most of our members have availed Professional Protection / Indemnity schemes offered by various insurers to safeguard their interests in the event of any complaints of medical negligence. This article is to make them aware of our own scheme effectively implemented by IMA KSB. There are plenty of reasons for all of you to switch over to our own scheme instead of the schemes offered by other insurers.

The highlights are mentioned below...

- 1) It is based on mutual contribution concept, more the number of members in the scheme the less will be the amount that one has to pay every year.
- 2) General practitioners & all specialists are covered with same premium as all the members belong to IMA as one without any differentiation.
- 3) It covers the individual member's practice irrespective of the place of practice and also number of consulting places in Karnataka. This is a very important point to be noted as all other insurers insist on giving details of the places where each one practises. In case you practice /operate in a place which is not mentioned in the policy they refuse to indemnify you if any adverse event takes place.
- 4) Guidance & Help is available right from the time of filing the complaint / reply to notice unlike other insurers who just compensate after the penalty is awarded. Guidance and help at the most stressful time is what everyone needs.
- 5) The scheme covers up to 1 CRORE with a very reasonable premium. At the time of joining one has to pay a very basic amount of Rs 3100. Other insurers charge between 10000 20000 every year for the same amount of coverage.
- 6) Yearly premium is just Rs 500 unless there is a compensation awarded in that year. Even if a compensation amount of Rs 1 crore is awarded the amount to be shared by all the members will come to just Rs 5000 to 6000 per member which is very low. Other insurers charge the same premium every year whether there is any compensation awarded or not.
- 7) With other insurers even if one has a coverage of Rs 1 crore, only 40 50 % can be claimed per accident / incident which is mentioned in the policy document as AOA (Any One Accident) and AOY (Any One Year) which not many are aware. So the insured will have to bear the remaining amount from his pocket. But in IMA scheme whole amount is shared which I feel is the biggest advantage of IMA KPPS.
- 8) This scheme is very advantageous particularly for those who are starting their careers after completing graduation / post graduation / super specialization as the contribution per year is very nominal.
- 9) There is a tie up with Pan India legal firm PSL Advocates and Solicitors which has an office at Bangalore. They will help the members throughout as per the requirement.
- 10) Since it works on mutual contribution concept, more the number of members less will be the share borne by each member. So I hereby request all the members of our state to join this scheme at the earliest and save a considerable amount of their hard earned money which they are paying to the private insurers.
