1) WORLD BREAST FEEDING WEEK:- AUGUST 1 -AUGUST 7

World Breastfeeding Week is celebrated every year across the world from August 1 - August 7. This global campaign aims to raise awareness about breastfeeding and its advantages. Following a surge in the infant mortality rate due to a drop in the number of mothers who wanted to breastfeed, the initiative became essential. While everyone has the right to make their own decisions, breastfeeding is recommended by the World Health Organization (WHO) until a child turns two.

This year, the theme is "Step up for Breastfeeding -Educate and Support". The year's campaign will focus on strengthening the capacity of actors that have to protect, promote and support breastfeeding across different levels of society. Target audiences including governments, health systems, workplaces and communities will be informed, educated and empowered to strengthen their capacity to provide and sustain breastfeeding-friendly environments for families in the post pandemic world.

Breastfeeding is key to sustainable development strategies post-pandemic, as it improves nutrition, ensures food security and reduces inequalities between and within countries.

2) National Eye Donation Fortnight:- 25TH August- 8TH September

"Sarvendriyanam Nayanam Pradhanam"

The National Eye Donation Fortnight is observed every year from 25th August to 8th

September. It is a campaign which aims to create mass public awareness about the importance of eye donation and to motivate people to pledge their eyes for donation after death.

Blindness due to corneal disease is one of the major eye-related public health problems in India. Currently, there are 4.2 billion corneal blind people across the globe. In India, there are around 1.2 million corneal blind persons in India. Among this, 10% are children. One in every 1000 children is blind due to corneal disease. Around 20000 to 30000 cases are added every year to this number. The major causes of corneal blindness are infection, injury to the eye due to chemicals, congenital corneal opacity disease. Common causes include corneal dystrophy and degeneration and trachoma. The most common causes of unilateral and bilateral corneal blindness reported were keratitis during childhood, trauma and keratitis during adulthood. The major reasons for not donating eyes are refusal to discuss the issue, not being aware of the need for eye donation, lack of knowledge about how to donate, scared about legal problems and religious beliefs. Illiteracy and rural residence are strong predictors of ignorance about eye donation. Insufficient facilities in the institutes and hospitals and Social and religious myths

Eye donation is an act of donating one's eyes after his/her death. It is an act of charity, purely for the benefit of the society and is totally voluntary.

Anyone can donate their eyes irrespective of age, gender and blood group. The cornea should be removed within 6 hours of death. Eyes of the

donated person can save the vision of two OR more corneal blind people. It takes only 10-15 minutes and leaves no scar or disfigurement of the face. People with diabetes, hypertension, asthma and who have undergone cataract surgery can also donate eyes. Eyes can be donated even if pledging was not done before death, a relative of the deceased can decide about eye donation.

COVID-19 has had a negative impact on eye donation perceptions. An estimated 12.7 million patients are waiting for corneal transplants worldwide and because of the pandemic this demand is expected to rise significantly. Utilisation of a single tissue for multiple transplants either as anterior/posterior lamellar grafts or by dividing a single layer into multiple grafts have been carried out to make the maximum use of the available cornea. In addition, research on whether SARS-cov-2 can be completely eliminated from an ex vivo donor cornea will be extremely necessary in order to recover the currently reduced supply and distribution of donor tissues for corneal transplants. Medical researchers and scientists are working on developing artificial cornea but till that time, donating the eyes would be the best gift ever for a blind person suffering from corneal blindness

In conclusion, efforts have to be made to educate the general public and the medical fraternity about the importance as well as the need for eye donation.

DONATE YOUR EYES, LET IT SPREAD THE LOVE AND LIGHT EVEN AFTER YOUR DEATH.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings from IMA KSB on the occasion of 75th Independence day celebration of our mother India 'Ajadi ka Amrith Mahostav'. In the last 75 years, India has grown by leaps and bounds to the extent that India is expected to be 3rd biggest economy in the world in near future. In spite of dishonest politicians and rulers, the country has marched ahead in every field. Medical field is no exception. India is most sought destination for medical tourism. Medical tourism is progressing year by year, thanks to foundation laid by MCI and hardworking intelligent Indian doctors.

However replacing autonomous body MCI by NMC by present government is a retrospective step. NMC is antidemocratic as there are only few elected representatives in NMC, rest are all nominated. It is antifederal as only few states are represented at a given time. It is Anti poor as it allows private medical colleges to fix their own fees. NMC is pro-myopathy as it promotes myopathy. Our apprehension about NMC are coming true as central Government is supporting myopathy by allowing MS coarse by ayush to be trained under our own faculty as per CCIM notification. Even New Education Policy declares by 2030 only integrated medical education will be existing in India. Drugs and cosmetic act 1940 is amended to dilute the medical ethics. Ban on advertisement of drugs & cure for diseases, as per magic remedies act is missing in New drugs, Medical devices and cosmetics act may lead to unhealthy competition.

The verdict of Chennai High Court allowing ayush doctors to use modern medicines is against orders of Supreme Court, needs to be challenged.

Central act on violence is kept in cold storage,

promise of IMS for administration in health & medical education at par with IAS, IPS, IFS is still a dream. Government is irrationally increasing number of medical colleges and medical seats, though it cannot provide enough jobs to newly coming doctors. It is going to create unemployment in medical field. Recent statement given by health minister in parliament that there are more than 13.5 lakh modern medicine doctors and more than 6.5 lakh ayush doctors registered in the country, we have a better than WHO prescribed Doctor to population ratio 1:1000. In several states like Karnataka it is 1:500. IMA needs to discuss all these issues to provide better future for our profession.

Doctor's day was celebrated on 1st July at Babu Rajendra Alumni Hall, BMCRI, Bangalore in befitting way. Many of our Past Presidents of IMA KSB graced the occasion. For the first time in the history of IMA KSB doctor's from every district were felicitated. On 23rd July IMA AMS & CGP conference was held under the auspices of IMA Gadag at GIMS auditorium. Dr. Ravindra Wankhedkar treasurer world medical association and past president IMA HQ was the chief guest, who appreciated the activities and innovative ideas of IMA KSB of District council & district level FOMA. He advised to send these amendments to IMA headquarters to be considered in Central council. On the same day Doctor's Day programme of IMA Gadag, where many doctors were felicitated for their service to the society and profession. I participated in Annual CME & Doctor's Day programme of IMA Belgaum on 24th July 2022.
