1) Breast Cancer Awareness Month 2022 (October 1 to October 31):-

Every year Breast Cancer Awareness Month (BCAM) is observed in the month of October, from 1st to 31st. The annual international health campaign aims to increase awareness of the disease and to raise funds for research into its cause, prevention, diagnosis, treatment and cure. The pink ribbon is an international symbol of breast cancer awareness.

This year **we RISE** is the theme to ensure every woman has access to the screenings she needs and the support she deserves.

Breast cancer is the commonest malignancy among women globally. From being fourth in the list of most common cancers in India during the 1990s, it has now become the first.

Epidemiological studies have shown that the global burden of Breast Cancer is expected to cross almost 2 million by the year 2030. In India, the incidence has increased significantly, almost by 50%, between 1965 and 1985.

Current trends point out that a higher proportion of the disease is occurring at a younger age in Indian women, as compared to the West. The survival rate of patients with breast cancer is poor in India as compared to Western countries due to earlier age at onset, late stage of disease at presentation, delayed initiation of definitive management and inadequate/fragmented treatment. According to the World

Cancer Report 2020, the most efficient intervention for Breast Cancer control is early detection and rapid treatment.

A robust awareness campaign and effective implementation of a national cancer screening program are the need of the hour. The shortage of skilled manpower and infrastructural requirements need to be met and for this, the total healthcare budget of the country needs to be increased. In the jargon of the challenges of Breast Cancer control, prioritising the adoption of a preventive approach and early detection would go a long way. Creating a cadre of trained medical and paramedical professionals, efficient utilisation and timely upgrading of skills of the existing healthcare workforce along with adopting newer technologies would further the cause of Breast Cancer control. The field of breast surgery has also evolved from total mastectomy to breast conservation therapy to oncoplastic breast surgery. The rapidly advancing field of oncoplastic breast surgery offers a pragmatic alternative to total mastectomy and breast conservation therapy.

2) International Day of the Girl 2022:- October 11.

2022 commemorate the 10th anniversary of the International Day of the Girl (IDG). In these last 10 years,

Mushrooming of Medical Colleges in Karnataka.

Out of around 590 medical colleges in India, Karnataka already have 60 Medical Colleges and another five are in the pipeline. Out of 87,000 MBBS graduates produced in India every year, around 12,500 MBBS graduates are from Karnataka. Though about 20% are from all India quota and few may go abroad, majority have to settle down in Karnataka with or without post graduation. Six States including Karnataka already have more doctors than WHO guidelines on doctor to population ratio of 1:1000. Many of the colleges by hook or crook, irrespective of the infrastructure have raised the UG intake to 200 and even 250 seats per year. This gives a threat to bring down the doctor population ratio in Karnataka to less than 1:500 down the line in the coming years.... So this may pose a threat of unemployment among the doctors in the state and also brings down the dignity and respect of the medical profession at large. In addition equal number of AYUSH

doctors and the prevailing quackery, further worsens the unemployment issue of allopathy doctors in our state. By and large, there is a **"Disaster in making"** in our state in the coming decade. unless Indian medical association takes lead role in educating and bringing awareness among the Government, the policy makers, health Universities and the NMC. Through this I urge the IMA- KSB, MSN & JDN to wake up and be ready to take necessary steps to prevent the upcoming disaster to the medical profession in our state.
