

World Health Day Celebrations:

World health day 2023 Theme: HEALTH FOR ALL!

The month was dedicated to celebrating "HEALTH" with WHO declaring a worldwide celebration of 75th year of its existence! Accordingly, IMA HQ, decided to celebrate the world health day; 7th April with plethora activities and directed the IMA branches across the country to observe and celebrate it memorably. Headquarters suggested a to like walkathon, appreciation and felicitation of the healthcare workers, who saved innumerate lives during COVID19 pandemic, seminars in association with various other medicine systems and shining light- celebrating health with lighting of the lamps in the evening. On the same day, Rajasthan Government withdrew the bill and adopted a much diluted bill excluding most of the hospitals from ambit of the act and hence fulfilling the demand of the striking doctors. IMA KSB demonstrated its commitment to the cause of the members and profession with appropriate steps and participation and it was well appreciated.

discussed the concerns about non progressiveness of various anti-quackery cases. The issue was discussed and decided to speed up the process with writing to the concerned authorities. World Hemophilia Day

April 17th is observed as World Hemophilia Day annually, commemorating the birthday of Frank Schnabel, who founded the World Federation of Hemophilia. The theme for 2023 is "Access for All: Prevention of Bleeds as the global standard of Care. WFH call upon the community to come together and advocate with local policy makers and Governments for improved access to treatment and care with an emphasis on prophylaxis, the only gold standard treatment to prevent disabilities & lead better quality of life.

Hemophilia is a congenital bleeding disorder caused by the deficiency of certain clotting proteins in the blood with characteristic X linked recessive mode of inheritance, affecting males predominantly. The most common deficiency is Factor VIII followed by Factor IX, known as Classical Hemophilia or Hemophilia A & Christmas disease or Hemophilia – B respectively. Though incurable but

temporarily manageable. The only remedy is replacement of deficient of clotting protein (Anti Hemophilic Factor) at every instance of bleed, known as episodic treatment or periodical replacement of AHF to prevent the tendency of bleeding known as Prophylaxis.

Hemophilia is a complex disorder that can be associated with significant morbidity & lifelong treatment. Repeated bleeding into joints& muscles can lead to the development of deforming, painful arthropathies which impair quality of life & have implications on education, employment, productivity & other Psychosocial aspects.

Hemophila is distributed worldwide with equal frequencies in all ethnic group & geographic areas. The disorder has an incidence of 1 in 5000 and 1 in 25,000 male births, respectively, with a prevalence of approximately half-a-million people worldwide. In India, about 25,000 patients with Hemophilia are identified by Hemophilia Federation, India & but with population of 1.32 billion, the prevalence of Hemophilia is 1 in 10,000 general population, the expected number of PWH should have been




1,32,000. About 3000 patients are identified among the estimated about 6000 in Karnataka State.

I am happy & proud to mention about the great efforts of Karnataka Hemophilia Society in Davangere, Non-Profit Organization working for the welfare of Persons with Hemophilia (PwH) and related Bleeding Disorders. Dr.Suresh Hanagavadi who himself is a sufferer with Hemophilia founded KHS in 1989-90. His hemophilic maternal uncle's death to life-threatening bleed without timely treatment determined him to become doctor and work towards developing hemophilia care services in Karnataka and working as Professor of Pathology at JJM Medical College, Davangere.

KHS is providing Diagnosis, Treatment and Rehabilitation services to the patients with all inherited bleeding disorders under one roof. I am proud to be associated & involved in organizing public/ media awareness, education & training of medical & paramedical professionals, Diagnosis & Treatment, Rehabilitation Camps (Children/ Youths) for motivating hemophilia families, Parents Meetings etc. since more than 3 decades. I request all the members & branches to support KHS in organizing medical updates on Hemophilia. On this occasion we IMA KSB are conducting CME on Hemophilia in collaboration with KHS @ Chitradurga, eminent speakers like Dr Suresh Hanagavadi and Dr.Shashikala P have given their consent for the same. Link for the same will be shared soon. It is highly needed to support the initiative of Dr Suresh Hanagavadi and improve the quality of services to patients with hemophilia and other inherited bleeding disorders in our state. Also if any local braches willing to conduct the CME haemophilia please contact us, we are just a call away.....



Career Guidance

Research After MBBS : A Comprehensive Guide to Opportunities in India and Abroad

After completing MBBS, medical graduates can explore various opportunities in India and abroad. The career options available for MBBS graduates depend on their interests and career aspirations. In this article, we will discuss some of the most popular career paths after MBBS.

Pursuing research through three-year medical postgraduate programme (MD or MS):

Postgraduates will be exposed to research through their curriculum designed by National medical commission (NMC), India. But due to high patient load and inadequate benefits due to research, not many people tend to be involved in research. After MD/MS, one can do research through the hospitals/medical colleges in which they are going to work. Another way is collaborative research with peers in other hospitals/medical colleges. People with MD Pharmacology/Microbiology/Physiology/Biochemistry usually have good research opportunities in academia. People who pursue MD pharmacology can work as clinical trial coordinators. Clinical trials are studies that test new drugs or treatments on human subjects. They are responsible for managing clinical trials and ensuring that they are conducted ethically and safely. Clinical trial coordinators can work in pharmaceutical companies, hospitals, or research organizations. After MD/MS in any branch, people can pursue PhD and be involved in research.

PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) after MBBS - Nurturing Clinical Scientists (NCS) by ICMR:

A MBBS Graduate can get direct admission to PhD in many subjects in many reputed universities / institutions, including ICMR, AIIMS and Others. The Scheme of ICMR Nurturing Clinical Scientists has been instituted to foster high-quality research opportunities for Fresh MBBS/BDS candidates, within two years of completing their degrees (Interns/MD/MS/MDS are NOT eligible) in the cutting edge areas Fundamental Basic/Clinical Research incommunicable and noncommunicable diseases, and reproductive health including nutrition etc. at MCI/DCI recognized medical colleges/ICMR network of Institutes/Centers, among others. The selected candidates will enroll themselves for pursuing a Ph.D. in any UGC recognized University/MCI/DCI recognized medical colleges/institutes. Three years (2+1) or submission of Ph.D. thesis (whichever is earlier).

PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) in Abroad:

Similarly, people can apply for Ph.D. for abroad universities. Let me clarify here that, unlike in India, you don't need a master's degree to be eligible for a PhD. In fact, with a fouryear bachelor's degree, you are eligible for a PhD. Apart from a bachelor's degree, you need a decent GRE score, TOEFL score, statement of purpose (SOP), and letter of recommendation (LORs). Previous research experience and publication are good to have but not necessary. Amongst all the above-mentioned requirements, GRE is the single most important parameter that can make or break your application. You need to check with individual universities' websites and apply for it.

Master in Public Health (MPH):

Public health is a field that focuses on improving the health of populations through research, education, and intervention programs. MBBS graduates can work in public health departments, non-governmental organizations, or international organizations such as the World Health Organization. A Master's degree in public health can help graduates to enter this field. An MBBS graduate from India can pursue MPH either in India or abroad. In India, many institutions offer MPH. Few include, JIPMER, PGIMER, AIIMS, IIPH, NIE, NIMHANS and many more. Regarding universities abroad - You need to check with individual universities websites and apply for it.

ICMR Scheme For MD/MS-PhD Programme:

The programme is designed to identify young medical graduates with brilliant academic records for pursuing postgraduate qualifications & to motivate them to opt for a career in its research cadre. The selection of the candidates will be made on the basis of a competitive National level examination consisting of a written test conducted at 3 or 4 Centres in the country. The candidate passing all MBBS examinations in the first attempt with 60% or more aggregate marks will be eligible for the examination. Under this programme, the selected medical graduates would be provided financial assistance for 4-5 years and a total of 25 fellowships will be available per year. (Programme is ongoing at three Centres viz., King George's Medical University (KGMU), Lucknow; National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (NIMHANS), Bengaluru and SRIHER (Sri Ramachandra Institute of Higher Education and Research), Chennai.

Pursuing research after passing USMLE and PLAB:

The United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE) is a three-step examination program for medical licensure in the United States. The Professional and Linguistic Assessments Board test (PLAB test), helps us to make sure doctors who qualified abroad have the right knowledge and skills to practise medicine in the UK. After clearing USMLE and PLAB, we can join residency and practice in US and UK respectively. In both countries, research is integral part of residency. The accessibility, funding and opportunities will be more and interested people can pursue research simultaneously.

Others:

- You may appear for CSIR NET exam and join as a JRA (junior research assistant) in the field and institute of your choice including IISc, CCMB and all the IITs.
- Other similar courses to pursue research are MSc Clinical Research, D.Phil at various universities in India and abroad.
- Master in Medical Science and Technology (MMST) by IIT Kharagpur.

- Rajiv Gandhi Centre for Biotechnology under the Government of India functioning at Poojappura, Thiruvananthapuram, offers major research programmes in disease biology and molecular medicine as well as plant biotechnology and discovery.
- Meritorious MBBS graduates can opt M.Tech. programmes in medical nanotechnology or nano medical sciences. But limited opportunities are available for study. In Kerala, Amrita Centre for Nano Sciences under Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS), Kochi, conducts M.Tech. nano medical sciences. Total seats: 20. This programme is fully-funded by the Department of Science and Technology.
- Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centre for Biomedical Research under the University of Delhi offers M.Sc.-Ph.D. combined degree in biomedical sciences.

In conclusion, there are far more opportunities for research for MBBS graduates in India than most people realize. MBBS graduates have a wide range of research career opportunities in India and It is important for graduates to explore their interests and choose a career path that aligns with their goals and aspirations.

WDW Activities - Hassan





Before leaving to Bangalore we visited the famous Adi Shankaracharya temple which is dedicated to lord Shiva in Srinagar.


Kashmir a must visit snow destination and the best time to visit is during December to March.
