AMS Conference: AMS Conference at Tumkur was a hugely successful one with great registrations and academic sessions. Sincere thanks to the IMA KSB AMS team and the IMA Tumkur.

reconsider the decision and revoke it. IMA KSB also wrote to the National President on the issue. IMA KSB stands to safeguard the medical students, medical education and the future of healthcare in India. We hope, our letter will show the way for GOI to introduce a better system to fill the left over seat with meritorious students.

It's easy to stand with the crowd, but takes courage to stand alone and lead the path!

IMA KSB rose to the occasion and stood for the justice on ZERO Eligibility for PG-NEET!

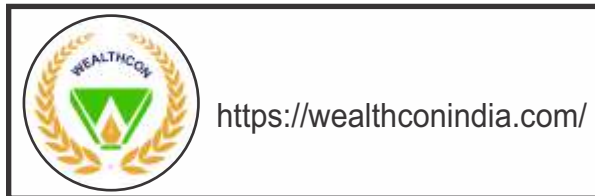

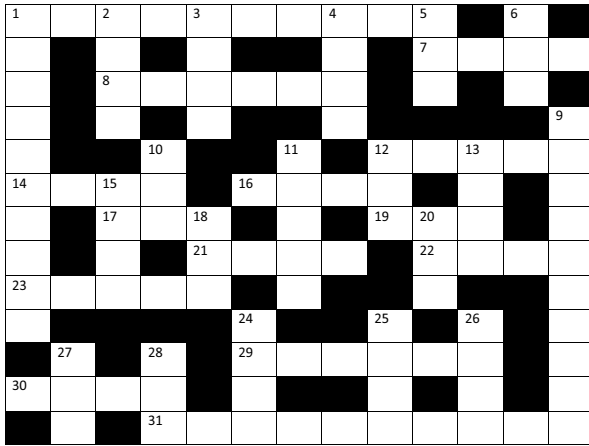

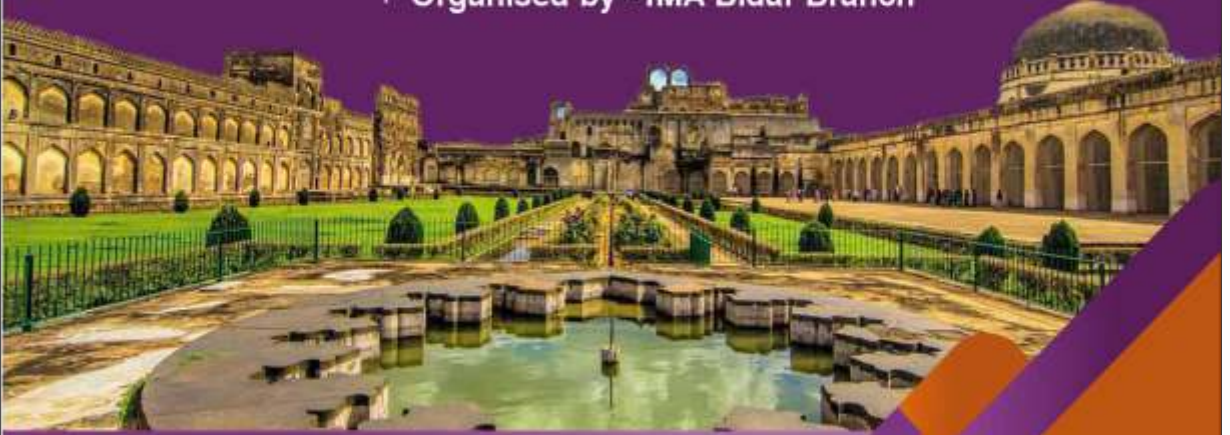
