

- 5. Horizontal grills and doors should be fitted with reliable locks
- 6. Space for School Bags
- 7. Qualified attendant
- 8. Parent/teacher may also travel
- 9. Driver should have 5 years' experience driving heavy vehicles
- 10. Driver who has been fined more than twice in a year cannot be employed

Though this month is cervical cancer awareness

Radio program on cervical cancer is organised on 27th of this month. Awareness jatha on the roads of Hassan organised on 30.1.24 to create awareness and cervical cancer and HPV vaccine among public

Pamphlets containing information about cervical cancer and breast cancer are prepared for public awareness.

Guidance will be given to encourage and guide these programs in other districts as well.

# 2) Thank you, Sir. Very interesting to know your childhood days. What about your higher education?

I did my MBBS from Govt medical college, Bellary between 1987 & 1993. Did my D. Otho from Mysore medical college in 1997.

During MBBS, I started taking part in college athletics and used to represent our University in Medicon annual meets. I use to take part in long distance events.

# 3) What about your employment?

I joined Govt service in 1997 and served in Koppal, M.N.Hosalli PHC later Served in Govt hospital Channapatna as Orthopedic surgeon. After serving for 12 years in Govt. hospitals took voluntary retirement and started exclusive orthopedic Centre (MOTC) in Channapatna in 2008.

# 4) Sir, Even as a busy doctor you are fit to participate in sport competitions. What is the secret?

In 2011, with my orthopedic friend Dr.Shankar.T.V started cycling and cycled to cover about 30,000 Kms. We cycled to Kanyakumari, Ooty, BRP and other various places. I have done a lot of trekking Covered most of the trekking spots in Karnataka. My Recent trek was to "Everest Base Camp (EBC)" 145 Kms in 9 days-, I have done this with my Children we did this in April-May, 2023.

### 5) What are your routines now to keep yourself fit?

My Routine is getting up at 5.45 AM playing tennis for about  $1\ 1/2$  hrs 4-5 days a week. Go to our Agriculture land at least 4-5 days a week and work there for 1 hour at least. Most of the time, I use cycle while going to tennis & agricultural land.



Greetings from IMA HQs.!

As you are aware, the WORLD CANCER DAY is on 4th Feb

UICC gave the clarion call to observe WORLD CANCER DAY in the year 2000 and since then is being observed across the world, to create awareness, improve education & emphasize personal, collective, NGO, civil societies & government action, to work together to prevent the millions of preventable cancer deaths and provide access to life saving cancer treatment & care, equitable to all.

Year 2024 is, the Third & final year of three year UICC campaign – "CLOSE THE CARE GAP" as everyone deserves access to cancer care. The theme is to identify & address the barriers that exist for many people in India and the world to access the care they need.

Cancer, continues to be the second leading cause of death worldwide. Each year, around 10 million people die from cancer, equivalent to around 26,300 deaths every day due to cancer and the number is predicted to rise to 13 million cancer deaths by 2030. With over 20 million new cancer cases every year, the global economic cost of cancer has been estimated to be \$1.16 Trillions. Among many of the cancer patients and cancer survivors are people who lead a disability-adjusted life or a life with several restrictions and precautions in place. However, 10% of cancers are due to genetic mutations and 27% of cancer deaths in the world are due to most preventable causes-tobacco & alcohol, although this incidence may be higher in India.

As per the Indian Council of Medical Research -National Cancer Registry, India- the estimated number of incident cases of cancer in India for the year 2022 was found to be 14,61,427 (crude rate:100.4 per 100,000) which is projected to increase as previous studies have shown & estimated a 12.8% increase in the number of annual cancer cases by the year 2025, which would be around 1.57 million. In India, every 9<sup>th</sup> person is likely to develop cancer in his/her lifetime. Lung and breast cancers were the leading sites of cancer in males and females, respectively. The majority of the patients with cancer were diagnosed at the locally advanced stage for breast (57.0%), cervix uteri (60.0%), head and neck (66.6%), and stomach (50.8%) cancer, whereas in lung cancer, distant metastasis was predominant among males (44.0%) and females (47.6%). The incidence of cancer cases is estimated to increase by 12.8 per cent in 2025 as compared to 2020. A wide heterogeneity in leading cancer sites has been observed within India by age and sex.

IMA joins hands with WHO to "Eliminate Cervical Cancer by 2030", we also urge the Ministry of Health, GOI to include <u>HPV vaccination in the National Immunization schedule of the appropriate age of the girls</u> and help control cervical cancer, so that no female ever dies of Ca Cervix. IMA calls for a comprehensive approach to preventing, detecting and treating cervical cancer. In India, a study among rural women with cervical cancer found the five-year survival rate to be 78% when diagnosed & treated at an early Stage but this drops down to 9%, when diagnosed in Stage IV, hence the need for early detection & treatment.

In India BREAST CANCER has highest incidence & death amongst all cancers in men & women combined. Its incidence in both sex's together is 13.5% (178361pts.) amongst all cancers as compared to Lip & Oral Cavity

10.3 % (135929), followed by Cervix Uterus (9.4%)& Lung (5.5%). In females with cancers, 26.3 % are due to breast cancer, 18.3% Cervix Uterus, Ovary 6.7% & Lip Oral Cavity 4.6%. (Globocan2020)

CANCER can also be labeled as a <u>life style disease</u>, as Smoking is the leading cause of 13 different types of cancers, Alcohol -7 types and Obesity 12 types and these are the biggest and most preventable cancer risk factors. Nearly, 40-50% of cancers are preventable.

IMA suggests that to reduce the cancer risk, the people should adopt a healthier behavior:-

- 1. Choose healthy food.
- 2. Stay active, keep moving,
- 3. Quit smoking/chewing Tobacco/using tobacco in any form.
- 4. Cut down on Alcohol.
- 5. Avoid pollutants and harmful chemicals including asbestos, pesticides & containers with BPA.
- 6. Get vaccinated against HPV.
- 7. Eat a diet rich in whole grains, vegetables, fruit, and beans.
- 8. Eat a diet low in highly processed foods, red and processed meat, sugar-sweetened drinks.
- 8. Know about the cancer symptoms & signs & act on it.

IMA also supports the call of UICC to illuminate city landmarks in "Orange & Navy Blue color" to draw attention of public for cancer awareness. (If dual color not possible then only Orange may be used),

Due to the ageing of the building a visionary resolution was made during the 76thMeeting of the Central Council, held at Delhi on 27th and 28thDecember 2015 to set in motion the process of Re-development of IMA HQs. Building. Various structural engineers have indicated that the IMA HOs. existing building is over 65 years old and it is nearing the end of its structural life.
