Our IMA KSB President Dr V V Chiniwalar along with Hon state secretary Dr Suriraju V, Hon State Treasurer Dr Shankarnarayanan K G along with all IMA KSB office bearers is carrying out all the important and challenging activities to uphold the dignity & decorum of State IMA along with all IMA branches with the respective Presidents, Secretaries, treasurers, OBs.

This month we are having so many awareness days on health: August 1-7: World Breastfeeding Week, August 1: World Lung Cancer Day, August 18: World Breast Cancer Research Day, August 19: World Humanitarian Day, August 31: International Overdose Awareness Day, August 1-31: Children's Eye Health and Safety Awareness Month, August 1-31: National Breastfeeding Month, August 1-31: National Immunization Awareness Month, August 1-31: Psoriasis Action Month, August 3: Cloves Syndrome Awareness Day, August 18-22: Contact Lens Health Week, August 30: National Grief Awareness Day. We request all the IMA branches in Karnataka to observe all these days to send the respective photos with small write up of branch activities to IMA Focus email ID: imafocus@gmail.com.

Day by day we are hearing so much news about sudden deaths among young people though they are very fit & healthy. Once death occur usually it is termed as cardio-respiratory failure or arrest and further no evaluation being done post deaths in these cases. Non-cardiac causes of sudden death in young age include various conditions.

Respiratory Issues: a. Asthma: Severe asthma attacks can lead to fatal respiratory distress. b. Pulmonary Embolism: A blood clot in the lungs can obstruct blood flow and cause sudden death.

Neurological Issues: a. Epilepsy: Sudden unexpected death in epilepsy (SUDEP) is a recognized phenomenon. b. Brain Hemorrhage /Aneurysm: Bleeding in the brain can rapidly lead to unconsciousness and death. c. Stroke: Clot formation or rupture in brain blood vessels can lead to massive brain damage and sudden death if not promptly addressed. d. Brain Injury: Traumatic brain injuries can cause internal bleeding, leading to pressure buildup, hydrocephalus, and herniation, which can be fatal without immediate treatment.

Gastrointestinal Issues: a. Severe Gastroenteritis: Can cause rapid dehydration and electrolyte imbalances leading to cardiac arrest. b. Perforative Peritonitis: A ruptured ulcer or other abdominal injury can lead to infection and shock.

Infections: Myocarditis: Inflammation of the heart muscle, often triggered by viral infections, can lead to sudden death.

Other causes include: a. Anaphylaxis: A severe allergic reaction can cause rapid swelling and breathing difficulties. b. Rhabdomyolysis: Breakdown of muscle tissue, sometimes triggered by intense exercise, can lead to kidney failure and sudden death. c. Commotio Cordis: A blow to the chest during a specific point in the cardiac cycle can cause sudden cardiac arrest in young individuals, even those with normal hearts. d. Sickle Cell Collapse: Can be triggered by exercise in individuals with sickle cell trait, especially in hot and humid conditions. e. Heatstroke: Can

lead to multi-organ failure and death. f. Metabolic Disorders: a. Hyponatremia (low sodium) and hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) can also be fatal. b. Inborn errors of metabolism: Certain rare genetic metabolic disorders, such as fatty acid oxidation defects, can lead to sudden death, particularly in infants. c. Adrenal insufficiency: Adrenal crises, often triggered by illness, can result in sudden death d. Sudden Infant Death Syndrome (SIDS): A leading cause of death in infants under one year, whose cause remains unexplained after thorough investigation. e. Hypertensive crisis: A sudden and severe increase in blood pressure can cause various complications, including stroke and heart attack, potentially leading to sudden death. f. Sepsis: Overwhelming infection can lead to septic shock and multiorgan failure, potentially resulting in sudden death. g. Drug overdose/substance abuse: Abuse of illicit or prescription drugs can lead to cardiac arrest, respiratory arrest, or other fatal complications.

While cardiovascular disease is the most common cause of sudden death overall, non-cardiac factors play a significant role, particularly in younger populations. Further research and awareness are crucial for a deeper understanding of the causes and prevention strategies of sudden death especially in young individuals.

"EACH ONE, BRING ONE" to enroll our medical colleagues & friends to become life member of IMA should continue to increase the strength of IMA at all levels.

The burning problem regarding the FIRE NOC is creating a havoc through out the state for all the hospitals for new registrations and renewals. IMA KSB has come to know that some of the DHO's are pressuring the hospitals to get the FIRE NOC. In this regard IMA KSB along with PHANA & KPMEA met Health Minister Sri Dinesh Gundurao, Health Commissioner Sri Harsha Gupta Fire department officials on 3rd April 2025 and apprised the situation. Recently on 17/07/2025 IMA KSB along with Kudligi MLA Dr N T Srinivas, myself, Dr Veerabhadraiah, Dr SuriRaju, Dr Shankaranarayan, Dr Madhushankar, Dr Pavankumar Patil met Home Minister Dr G Parameshwar at his home and explained the problem of FIRE NOC. He has assured to have the combined meeting of officials of Health, Home & Law ministries shortly. He told Dr NT Srinivas to raise the issue in Assembly. DR N T Srinivas is in continuous touch with the concerned authorities. IMA KSB is thankful to Dr NT Srinivas as he has taken this issue very seriously.

Within 2-3 months nearly 50-60% of hospitals are coming for renewals and new registrations. If this problem is not solved amicably then all the hospitals have to close and Doctors have to come to the streets.

Myself, Dr SuriRaju and Dr Veerabhadraiah met Justice Dr Ashok Hinchigeri Chairman Law Commission and two members of Law Commission at their chamber & briefed the situation and


