Chandrayaan 2 is launched successfully. The nation is proud yet again. Reaching the moon again has shown that sky is no limit to us. But, the problems in our profession lay still in the clouds. The amendment to consumer protection act, violence on doctors and medical establishments, quackery, 'n' number of new set of codes and rules to practice, KPMEA, new series like NABH, NEET, NEXT, NMC seem to be lined up in a queue to pour out on us.

As I write this editorial, we learn that NMC bill is passed in the Loka Sabha and probably when you start reading this editorial; it would be passed in Rajya Sabha too. Just a while ago, we were all elated when the NMC bill was not tabled during the last session. The moral of the story is, just a delay in passing a bill is not the dead end! It happened with KPMEA also. Government is a smart Alec. It will ultimately pass what it wants to, no matter how many countless hours we stand on streets in protest. Our silent marches, protest bundhs, withdrawal from non emergency services, meeting ministers and their allies, submitting memorandums have only created more e-waste and filled more dustbins. This has become tradition to us and we don't seem to know any other way. We are found more on streets than in our operating fields. At this rate, we may have to plan to buy plots in front of our DC offices and hire a permanent space at Freedom Park in state's capital to sit for dharna. None seem to take a good pulse of our professional pains. Public, patients and politicians are immune to our cries. The government proclaims to bring justice to medical education and profession by abolishing MCI and introducing NMC and we, the professionals seek to reform MCI and retain democracy for the students and professionals. They state they have chosen a body for us to elect and we say, we need elections to select a body to govern the profession. Both claim for democracy. Can you fault the logic? Once NMC bill gets passed in the lower house, the revolution will be over. What next? Yes, NEXT (National Exit Test) is waiting to be fought next!

The Karnataka kurukshethra to prove majority and acquire power in assembly is over. But, the mega serial on violence over medical professionals is continuing. The incidents at Sagar, Shikaripura and Gangavathi were on mainstream media this month in the state. Gangavathi IMA branch has shown a silver lining over the violence cloud. The entire Gangavathi town shut down its complete medical services including emergencies to show that enough had been tolerated by the doctors. The solidarity and support by IMA state heads and participation of public organizations could show that doctors can retaliate and cause inconvenience to the society if not taken into confidence. For all those who expect IMA to intervene in such events, IMA KSB has categorically shown that IMA can be an umbrella to you if you are ready to walk in the rain. Before our roars diminish and tides turn off, let there be light, 'the saviour needs saving'.

The month witnessed the first ever woman doctor's conclave held at Bellary. The event was well organized by the organizers putting in a lot of sweat and energy. Women crib for equality. But, I wonder where all these did disappear for a state event which soared with regional participation. Whatsapp well done and congratulatory messages do not justify the efforts of the organizers. A good attendance in physical form would be the greatest appreciation and award to the organizers who seek nothing more. If we do not participate in our own events, who else will? The same logic should apply to the forthcoming IMA KSB state conference being held at Chamarajanagar on 18th, 19th 20th of October 2019. Make up your minds to appreciate the organizers.

IMA KSB office received few complaints by some of the local branches regarding their branch activities not being featured in IMA Focus. I'm happy with the enthusiasm and interest shown by them in reading IMA FOCUS. Not to disappoint them, my "woman with wings" have flown off providing their space to accommodate more activities of the branches to encourage my enthusiastic readers. A gentle reminder to all my dear friends that you need to send your data before 20th of every month to be featured in focus as we do not have much memory space in the office now to carry over the given data to next month.

Before India plans to land on Venus, I wish the Saturn struck to the profession leaves us to practice allopathic medicine in peace, without the fear of being beaten up or being taken into the custody of the inquiry officer at all levels. On July 09 2019- We have conducted the CME on COSTING OF THE HEALTH CARE- AN EYE OPENER- By Dr Pavan patil, laparoscopic surgeon, gadag, IMA KSB costing committee member and also Different X Ray based cases- Dr. Lakhani, senior pediatrician, Gadag. On July 11 2019 Parent and Children health and education program at Briteway school, kampli.-Dr. S.G. Matti and Dr Srinivas Reddy addressed the program. On July 17-19th 2019 A big victory for strike conducted on behalf of the incident on the assault on doctors and hospital staff and also on hospital property against the culprits by getting arrested and filing a FIR with the support of many organisations like NIMA, AYUSH, IDA, Pharmacy association, Lab association, Nursing college, Various advocates, Some religious heads, Various NGO's, various political heads, and last but not least DC, SP, DySP, CPI, SI and PC's of police department including PRESS people who supported for this noble cause and we thank for all of them who supported us. On 14-07-2019 a patient by name Gouse Moinuddin aged 75 yrs got admitted at 10pm with Hyponatremic Encephalopathy, old Cerebro vascular accident, Rt. Hip bone fracture & Diabetes. At the time of admission Doctor has clearly informed about the prognosis and no guarantee about the life of a patient. Under Grave risk IV consent taken and treatment started. On 15/07/2019 there was slight improvement but on 16/07/2019 the condition deteriorating attenders were informed and advised to take the patient to higher CENTRE but attenders informed that after consultation with their relatives will take a decision. Next day on 17th July 2019 the patient was referred to higher center around 2pm advised to shift the patient in Ambulance. Dr Arjun went for lunch around 3.45pm. At 4pm the attenders were brought Autoriksha to take him home. The patient shifted to Auto. During this period unfortunately the patient had respiratory arrest. The hospital staff wanted to take the patient back into ICU. Immediately the attenders (Sons & others) started abusing and assaulted physically the hospital staff. By this time Dr Arjun arrived at the spot. Attenders started abusing and assaulted him physically. By this time all the IMA members and Police arrived at the spot and resolved by asking the attenders to take the body home. On the same day we approached the Police and lodged a complaint and FIR filed. IMA Gangavath has taken a decision to close our establishments till the action is taken against the Culprits. Other Associations

AYUSH,DENTAL,PHARMACY, LABORATORY &NURSING have extended their full support in favor of us. On 18-07-2018 a silent PROTEST MARCH was taken in the town. Submitted memorandum to TAHASILDAR of Gangavathi, Superintendent of Police of Koppal District and District Commissioner of KOPPAL. Information given to Local MLA & MP. All the local associations have extended their support. Dr Madhusudhan Kariganoor Elected President of IMA KSB attended yesterday and took part in Protest March and had come to Koppal to give memorandum. Dr Annadani Meti President of IMA KSB & Dr.Ravi Ranganath Chairman of Anti-Harassment Cell attended today's meeting and addressed the meeting. Deputy Superintendent of Police of GANGAVATHI addressed us at our IMA and assured us of arresting the culprits shortly. So now we the members of IMA Gangavathi are requesting you to take a stern action with the Government of India regarding this incident and not to recur such instances & to bring a stern ordinance to protect the life of DOCTORS-& Hospital staff and Hospital. Harassment on doctors committee, IMA KSB: *Regarding Gangavati IMA* . (1). Private hospitals/clinics closure including emergency till arrest happened. (2). All medical shops closed in support. (3). Open support from NGOs like Rotary, Lions club. (4). Not even one doctor thought of opening the hospital till arrest happens. (5). Local Lab technicians, nursing staff association complete support. (6). Some of the communities came forward to IMA meeting supporting doctors. (7). Ayush doctors also closed their setup till arrest happens. (8). Politicians also came to IMA meeting to express solidarity with doctors. (9). Advocate community had come to IMA meeting to express solidarity. (10). Local DYSP attended the IMA meeting & assured that arrest will happen today. (11). Press meet arranged during IMA meeting. (12). Press meet arranged after arrest to explain why IMA took this extreme step this time?. It is high time all local IMAs follow the same scenario in every episode of violence in the same manner. This is a benchmark which has been setup by Gangavati IMA Now. Everytime state IMA cannot call for closure. Please understand. Regarding Gangavati episode police also came under pressure to arrest the culprit as health care was collapsing in Gangavati. In all likely scenario state IMA will call for closure when time is right (ie violence episode+ working state government in place). Yesterday Elect president Dr.Madhusudan Karignur was in Gangavati whole day. Today state President Dr. Meti & myself are at Gangavati.**Dr. Ravi Ranganath, Chairman, harassment on doctors committee, IMA KSB.
